Parents should understand that the behavioral standards that we expect from our students and what we have outlined in our Handbook is what we believe that Scripture dictates to a person, even a child, who wants to live a life that is pleasing to the Lord. If a student continually and willfully rejects our behavioral standards, then it is clear that the family is not able to support our school and staff in its primary mission to honor Christ.

More specifically, parents will support our standards concerning swearing, vulgar language and joking, discussing and glorifying violent movies and video games, and purposeful drawing of attention to explicit innuendos, music, apps, etc. Students who choose to do these things are not a good fit for GCS and WILL BE disciplined immediately, up to and including expulsion.
